## To all clubs,

The new South East Bowls Region Match Committee has decided to maintain the four playing areas that were in place for the Zone 7 Championships and Pennants. A list of the playing areas is attached.

These playing areas aligned with the Women's Districts that were within the zone's boundaries.

The women have lost 2 clubs to the Illawarra Region, Bomaderry and Gerringong.

The new region now has 33 clubs in total with the ladies' club of Adaminaby coming in.

## Pennants:

The playing of all pennants will be conducted in these 4 playing areas where ever possible depending on entries. There will be some cases where we will have to combine areas to make a competition viable. Playing in these areas allows regional finals to be conducted over one weekend for both Open Pennants and Single Gender Pennants.

Pennant finals will be held at venues across the region areas. A projected venue list will be distributed when finalized.

All pennant finals will be played on weekends.

Both Single Gender Pennant finals, men and women, will be held on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

Open Gender Pennant Finals will be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of May 2025.

## Championships:

All championships, men and women, will be played on weekends in the designated playing areas with the area winners progressing to the finals. Our aim is to expose the women's game to people that wouldn't normally see them during the week and generate more interest at club level.

Championships will commence with the Region Fours on the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of September.

There will be 4 area winners of each competition, singles, pairs, triples and fours.

This will allow for all the championship finals to be completed over 2 weekends with semifinals and finals being played each day of the weekend.

Pairs finals, Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November. Triples finals, Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December.

Fours finals, Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> December. Singles finals, Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> December.

Spare finals dates, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> December.

We will be asking for EOI's from clubs to host sectional games and finals. Refer to calendar for dates.

Entry fee to all championships will be \$15 per player with good prizemoney on offer for regional winners.
